I chose St Louis to work hard and have fun and also to make new friends. I am so happy I chose St Louis and I hope that you will too because St Louis makes me feel safer and happier.

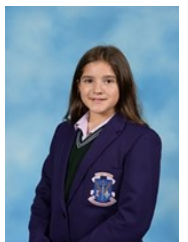


Ryan (8DR) Kilkeel

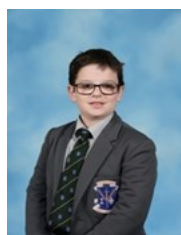
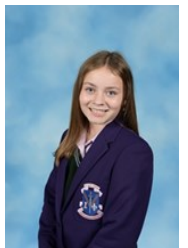


Daniel (8DR) Ballymartin
